come to life.

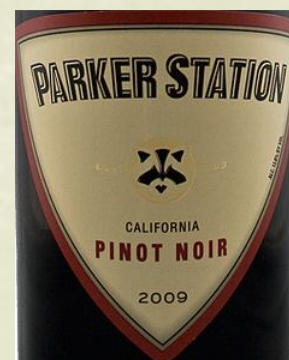
